Program Information

The Associate in Arts in Health Studies is a 61-63 credit degree designed to provide a strong foundation in health sciences while offering a flexible pathway toward a bachelor's degree. The curriculum mirrors the structure of the University's bachelor's programs, allowing students to apply most, if not all, completed coursework toward a future baccalaureate degree.

Students will complete a combination of core courses and free electives, many of which can be integrated into specific majors with the guidance of an academic advisor. Students may choose one of three concentrations within the Health Studies major; Public Health, Nutrition, Communication, Sciences, and Disorders. A minimum of 30 credits must be completed at La Salle University. This program is ideal for students seeking an entry point into the health sciences or for those planning to continue their studies at the bachelor's level.
